II. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE

- the abstract of your article (size from 1 to 3 pages, print 12; line spacing - single);
- the application of the conference participant for the <https://forms.gle/m9h4UhSYLQFr9jwj7>.

Until September 14, 2021 (if you want to your article will be published):

- the article drawn up in accordance with the requirements (page 2);
- the agreement on transfer of rights to publish (page 3);

The Organizing Committee has the right to select applications, reject materials submitted with violations of established requirements, or if the article does not contain sufficient scientific novelty. Participants who have not received confirmation within 3 days are requested to duplicate the materials or contact the Organizing Committee.

Key dates:

Before 06.09.2021 - acceptance of applications and theses for participation;

Before 14.09.2021 - acceptance of articles and agreements;

16.09.2021 - participants' registration and working start of the conference;

17.09.2021- finish the conference.

Following the conference, an electronic collection of scientific papers will be published (included in the **RSCI**).

III. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ARTICLE

The article should be written on a relevant topic and contain the results of independent research. It should not be published earlier or sent for publication to other publications.

The authors are solely responsible for the submitted material. The article will be published in the author's edition. No more than 3 articles are accepted from one author.

Upon receipt of the materials, the Organizing Committee reviews them within 3 working days and sends a letter to the author's email address indicating information about the acceptance of materials for publication or the need for amendments.

Rules and order of registration of articles:

1. Articles from 3 to 7 full pages of A4 format, made in the editor Microsoft Word, are accepted for publication.
2. Margins: 20 mm from all sides.
3. UDC index: size 12, normal, left alignment.
4. Title of the report: 12 point size, lowercase, Times New Roman, bold, center alignment, spacing after - 6 pt. Abbreviations are not allowed.
5. Surnames and initials of the authors: 12 point size, font Times New Roman, centered, no spacing.
6. City and name of the organization: 12 point size, font Times New Roman, italic, underlined, in the center, spacing after - 12 pt.
7. The main text of the report: 12 point size, Times New Roman font, width alignment, single line spacing, automatic hyphenation. The indentation of the first line of the paragraph is 1.27 cm.
8. Figures are executed in black and white mode, they should be drawn in a graphics editor Word and grouped. Figures are presented in the text (the visible size of the text in figures is 10-14 pt). Captions are centered, before and after 6 pt.
9. Bibliographic references (1 line indented from the text, in width). In the text, the reference number is indicated in square brackets.
Drawn up in accordance with GOST R 7.0.5-2008.
10. Pages are not numbered.
11. Originality of the text: not less than 50%. (preliminary check on the website: <https://www.antiplagiat.ru>).
12. Do not use footnotes.
